




Step Action

Click the **Start** button to the right of a chapter/section title to launch that module.




A pop-up window will open. If the window does not open, check that pop-ups are enabled and you are accessing the course through Google Chrome.

Click the chapter title near the top left of this new window.




9 On the next window that opens, click the **Play** button in the middle of the screen. The chapter will begin playing.



Step Action


Once you have completed the chapter, click **Exit** in the upper right corner of the course window. This will close the window.

Click the Start button to begin the next chapter.





Click either the **Start** button to begin the next chapter, or the **Continue** button to continue the chapter you left incomplete.




4 A new page will open for the chapter you are beginning. Select **Start**.




5 Select the checkbox in the top left corner of the new screen. If the pop-up does not appear, check that your pop-ups are enabled.




